11. MATTERS ARISING FROM FINANCE MEETING ON 22 JANUARY 2004

11.1 Budget for 2004/5

RESOLVED: that the recommended budget be approved.

11.4 Sandbach Christmas Lights Committee

RESOLVED: that the grant of £2,000 be approved.

RESOLVED: that the grant of £1,030 be approved.

12.2 Sandbach RUFC – World Cup in Sandbach

They ask if the Council is prepared to fund the cost of portable toilets for the event. Cllr Lloyd-Griffiths' membership of the Rugby Club was noted.

RESOLVED: that a grant of £350 be awarded.

12.3 Cheshire Police Authority – Meetings 2004/5

12.6 DWF - Safeway Store Licence Transfer

Transfer from James Dean and Andrew Woodcock to Anthony Bernard Salt and Andrew Woodcock.

RESOLVED: that the Council raise no objection.

12.8 Joint Highways – Closure of Church Lane between School Lane and Reynolds Lane

They propose the temporary closure to the above location commencing 1 March 2004 for a duration of 14 weeks whilst work is carried out in connection with construction of new traffic lights at junction 17, M6.

RESOLVED: that the Council approves the proposal.

12.9 CBC – Temporary Closure Church Lane

The Borough Council propose to prohibit traffic temporarily from Church Lane, Sandbach between School Lane and Reynold's Lane with effect from Monday 1st March 2004 for about three months.

RESOLVED: that the Council approves the proposal.

12.10 Joint Highways – Closure of A534 and Junction 17

They propose the temporary closure between the A5022 junction and the Petrol Station immediately West of the M6 from 2 April 2004 until 6 June 2004 (for overnight works as and when required) whilst work is carried out in connection with improvement measures to the M6 junction 17.

RESOLVED: that the proposals are accepted.

12.20 CBC – Pensioner Credits

CBC have issued a report regarding the introduction of the Pensioner Credit Scheme.

RESOLVED: that the report is received.
